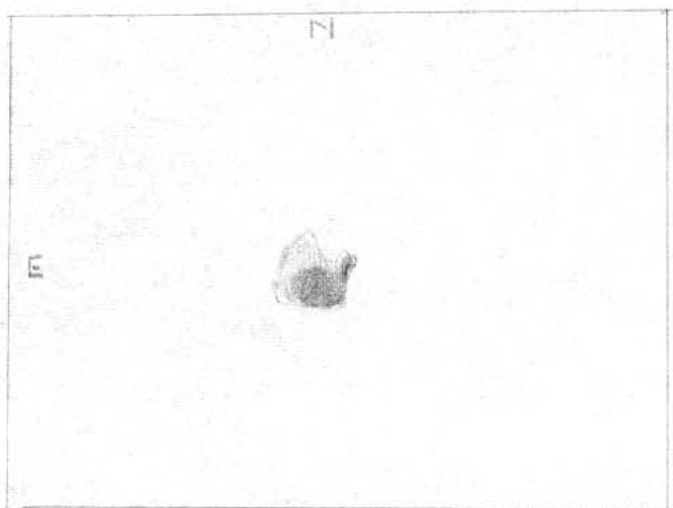


Comet Seki (1961 f)
