April 10, 1962. Evening

7 x 50 and 20 x 50 binoculars used, and an 8" f8 reflector. Again thin streaky clouds formed at dusk, hindering the view. A fairly brisk wind did nothing for our comfort. Estimated position: RA 2h 40m, Dec +24° brightness, 4.0mag. The comet could be seen quite readily with the naked eye.
