April 10, 1962. Evening

 $7 \times 50$  and  $20 \times 50$  binoculars used, and an  $8^n$  f8 reflector. Again thin streaky clouds formed at dusk, hindering the view. A fairly brisk wind did nothing for our comfort. Estimated position: RA 2h 40m, Dec  $+24^\circ$  brightness, 4.0mag. The comet could be seen quite readily with the naked eye.
