Thank-you for your last two letters, and for the reports and observations. You really had some good luck with Comet Humason. Yes, Comet Humason is quite an unusual object, and it is a "large" comet too. It never appeared too bright, however, as it remained some distance from both earth and sun.

Here is some news on the progress of the "search" part of the Comet and Nova Section. From January to July of this year, 14 observers in three Centres (Hamilton, Montbeal, and Niagara Falls) made 650 observations of 40 areas. Groth was gradual during the first few months, but July showed a sudden growth.

Several other Centres observed Comet Seki-Lines, and I expect good results with Comet Humason.
