In the latest summary of searches, mention was made of a "sear" - I once spotted something "new" in Area *1 but reference to a picture I had taken of the area showed it had been there before. It was an exceptionally clear night at that time. I have pictures (negatives) of Areas 99 & 384, and refer to them occasionally when a clear night shows another "new" object.

I hope you have had better weather? - I think I had my 8" out one night only during October.
