I am also a member of the B.A.A., and I am still awaiting the 1964 issue of the BAA Handbook which contains the required information. I spent last evening contacting other B.A.A. members in the Montreal area to see if they had received the above Handbook, but none had. Anyway, I doubt if there are any bright comets expected during the year (other than Encke). I keep a mental picture of bright periodic comets, and I can think of none due this year. Encke last past near the sun in February of 1961, and since it has a period of 3.3 years, it should be around again about June of this year.
