I have started to photograph constellations with a 35mm camera using Anscochrome 200 film. We hope to use them at our meetings to encourage constellation study. Maybe we might even catch a comet or nova on one of them! The camera rides piggy-back on my 8" f8 & is guided for exposures of 10 minutes to 30 minutes. An article in FEB. 1964 SKY & TELESCOPE seems to confirm the feasibility of this effort. The camera lens is f2.4 stopped down to 3.5.

I'm glad to hear you had a good night for the recent total lunar eclipse.

It looks like a good night tonight, but I have to take my wife to a Christmas party for our niece. That's life!
