You will be interested to know that the Comet was observed from the Astrophysical Observatory on the night of August 22nd, at 23.00 hrs P.D.S.T, 06.00 hrs U.T. August 23rd, using the 72" telescope with x400.


The instrument was set at the coordinates given in yours of August 20th, and was found at approximately this position.

This was the occasion of a visit to the Observatory by members of the "Summer Course" given by the Victoria Centre, designed for those unfamiliar with Astronomy. The instruments are exhibited and their uses explained by the staff of the Observatory.

We, (my wife and I) were able to have the Comet brought into field by members of the Staff, and it was seen by the Staff members present, and by some members of the Centre as well as those from the "Summer Course"

Mr. G. Ball and Mr. J.C.Parsons have been supplied with the coordinates and they will continue observing as we also shall do.
