Dear Mr. Dewing,

Thank you for your letter of 19 July. Enclosed are the forms describing the Comet and Nova Section. They should be self-explanatory, but if there are any problems, please let me know.

I regret that I do not have an ephemeris available for Comet Neujmin II. However, since it appears the ephemeris was not published by the Harvard Announcement cards, it must be very faint. The World Almanac seems to like publishing a table of many short-period comets which cannot be seen with amateur telescopes.

There is, however, a new comet which may be seen with binoculars during August. This is Comet Abe 1970g, and the approximate ephemeris is as follows:
