Dear Sir,

As mentioned in the paper, that you would like to have any notes of observations of the Eclipse of yesterday. I send - the following

My observation was made with a Suny or transit draped Eye piece. The sky was a good deal overcast with clouds but at the time of first contact the sun was quite clear. By our time here it was at 11^h 55-56. or between 55 & 56. minutes, and the last contact was at 14^h 53-54 - or between 53 & 54 minutes. The sky was somewhat hazy - so it was not easy with a Telescope of small power to tell accurately the exact times of contact and also not being
